

# Comparison of Seals, Trumpets, and Bowls

From the Book of Revelation and Other Key Scriptures (Updated Dec 2012)

Explanation: This table demonstrates how chapters 6-19 of Revelation are a series of visions from different camera angles. This means that there is repetition in the seals, trumpets, and bowls. Seals 1-5 appear to be before the time of Jacob's trouble (last 3 ½ years). Seals and 6 and 7 appear to encompass the rest of the tribulation to the very. The subsequent trumpets and bowls are looking at those events in either greater detail or from a different angle. There is also some intensification of the events (from 1/3 to everything). Question marks were placed where something was not absolutely certain. Words in red are from Jesus.

<p>"I was considering the horns, and there was another <b>horn, a little one</b>, coming up among them, before whom three of the first horns were plucked out by the roots. <p>When He opened the third seal...So I looked, and behold, a <b>black horse</b>, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. <b>(Rev 6:5)</b> And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A <b>quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius</b>; and do not harm the oil and the wine." <b>(Rev 6:6)</b> When He opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come and see." <b>(Rev 6:7)</b> So I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was <b>Death</b>, and Hades followed with him. <p>When He opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. <b>(Rev 6:9)</b> And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" <b>(Rev 6:10)</b> Then a white robe was given to each of them; <b>[Resurrection/rapture?]</b> and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both [<i>the number of</i>] their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they [<i>were</i>], was completed. <b>(Rev 6:11)</b></p>				
<h2 style="color: blue;">Four [Bad] Angels Wait to harm Earth, Sea, Trees</h2>				
<p>After these things I saw <b>four angels</b> standing at the <b>four corners of the earth</b>, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, on the <b>sea</b>, or on any tree. <b>(Rev 7:1)</b> Then I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God. And he cried with a loud voice to the <b>[bad] four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea</b>, <b>(Rev 7:2)</b> saying, "Do <b>not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees</b> till we have sealed the servants of our God on their</p>	<p><b>1<sup>st</sup> Trumpet:</b> The first angel sounded: And hail and fire followed, mingled with blood, and they were thrown to the earth. And a <b>third of the trees</b> were burned up, and <b>all green grass was burned up</b>. <b>(Rev 8:7)</b> Then the second angel sounded: And [<i>something</i>] like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the <b>sea</b> became blood. <b>(Rev 8:8)</b></p>		<p>(They [<i>locusts</i>] were commanded not to harm the <b>grass</b> of the earth, or any <b>green thing, or any tree</b>, but only those men who do not have the seal of God on their foreheads.) <b>(Rev 9:4)</b> ...sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the <b>four [bad] angels</b> who are bound at the great river Euphrates." <b>(Rev 9:14)</b> So the <b>four angels</b>, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, <b>were released to kill a third of mankind</b>. <b>(Rev 9:15)</b></p>

### Blood

Then the **second** angel sounded: And [something] like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the **sea**, and a third of the **sea** became **blood**. (Rev 8:8) And a **third** of the **living creatures in the sea died**, and a third of the ships were destroyed. (Rev 8:9) Then the third angel sounded: And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of **the rivers and on the springs of water**. (Rev 8:10)

Then the **second** angel poured out his bowl on the **sea**, and it became **blood** as of a dead [man;] and **every living creature in the sea died**. (Rev 16:3) Then the third angel poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became **blood**. (Rev 16:4) (Wormwood) And I heard the angel of the waters saying: "You are righteous, O Lord, The One who is and who was and who is to be, Because You have judged these things. (Rev 16:5) For they have shed the **blood** of saints and prophets, And You have given them **blood** to drink. For it is their just due." (Rev 16:6)

### Darkness When the Abyss Opens (5th Trump)

"And I will show wonders in the **heavens and in the earth: Blood and fire and pillars of smoke**. (Joel 2:30) The **sun shall be turned into darkness**, And the **moon into blood**, Before the coming of the great and awesome **day of the LORD**. (Joel 2:31)

Behold, the **day of the LORD** comes, Cruel, with both wrath and fierce anger, To lay the land **desolate**; And He will destroy its sinners from it. (Isaiah 13:9) For the **stars of heaven and their constellations Will not give their light**; **The sun will be darkened** in its going forth, And the **moon will not cause its light to shine**. (Isaiah 13:10)

Then the fourth angel sounded: And a third of the sun was struck, **a third of the moon**, and a third of the stars, so that **a third of them were darkened**. A third of the **day did not shine**, and likewise the night. (Rev 8:12) [**day and night don't shine when smoke is blocking the sky**]

And he opened the bottomless pit, and **smoke** arose out of the pit like the **smoke** of a great furnace. **So the sun and the air were darkened** because of the **smoke** of the pit. (Rev 9:2)

Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and **his kingdom became full of darkness**; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. (Rev 16:10)

### Intense Pain Inflicted From What Comes Out of Abyss

And they were not given [authority] to kill them, but to **torment them** [for] five months. Their **torment** [was] like the torment of a scorpion when it strikes a man. (Rev 9:5) In those days **men will seek death and will not find it**; they will desire to die, and death will flee from them. (Rev 9:6)

So the first went and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and a **foul and loathsome sore** came upon the **men who had the mark of the beast** and those who worshiped his image. (Rev 16:2) and they gnawed their tongues because of the **pain**. (Rev 16:10) They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their **pains and their sores**, and **did not repent** of their deeds. (Rev 16:11)

### River Euphrates

saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the **great river Euphrates**." (Rev 9:14) So the **four angels**, who had been prepared for the hour and day and month and year, were released to **kill a third of mankind**. (Rev 9:15) And **they did not repent** of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts. (Rev 9:21)

Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the **great river Euphrates**, and its water was dried up, so that the way of **the kings from the east** might be prepared. (Rev 16:12)

### Great Earthquake - Volcanic Mountain Thrown Into Sea (Just Before His Fall)

### Into the Caves

And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the **caves and in the rocks of the mountains**, (Rev 6:15) and said to the mountains and rocks, "fall on us and hide us from the face of him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the lamb! (Rev 6:16)

**Enter into the rock, and hide in the dust**, From the **terror of the LORD** And the glory of His majesty. (Isaiah 2:10)

### The Great Day [Day of the Lord] Has Come (It is Done)

"For The **Great Day Of His Wrath** Has Come, And Who Is Able To Stand?" (Rev 6:17)

Then the seventh angel sounded: And there were **loud voices** in heaven, saying, "**The kingdoms of this world have become [the kingdoms] of our Lord and of His Christ**, and He shall reign forever and ever!" (Rev 11:15) (Rev 11:17) The nations were angry, and **Your wrath has come**, And the **time of the dead**, that they should be **judged**, And that You should **reward Your servants** the prophets and the saints, And those who fear Your name, small and great, And **should destroy those who destroy the earth.**" (Rev 11:18)

...They go to the kings of the whole earth and gather them for the war of **the great Day of God** Almighty. (Rev 16:14) "**See, I am coming like a thief. How blessed is the person who remains alert and keeps his clothes on! He won't have to go naked and let others see his shame.**" (Rev 16:15) [**day of the Lord=thief in night**]  
Then the seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a **loud voice** came out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, "**It is done!**" (Rev 16:17)

for you yourselves know very well that the **Day of the Lord** will come like a **thief** in the night. (1Thess 5:2) However, brothers, **you are not** in the darkness, in order that the **Day of the Lord** might surprise you like a **thief**. (1Thess 5:4)

But the **Day of the Lord** will come like a **thief**. **On that day** the heavens will disappear with a roaring sound, the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything done on it will be exposed. (2Pet 3:10)

But be sure of this: if the owner of the house had known when during the night the **thief** would be coming, he would have **stayed awake** and not allowed his house to be broken into. (Matt 24:43) So you, too, must be **ready**, because at an hour you are not expecting him the **Son of Man will come.**" (Matt 24:44)

### Temple of God Opens / Noises, Thunderings, Lightnings, and an Earthquake

Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw [it] to the earth. And **there were noises, thunderings, lightnings, and an earthquake.** (Rev 8:5)

Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were **lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.** (Rev 11:19)

And there were **noises** and **thunderings** and **lightnings**; and there was **a great earthquake**, such a mighty and great **earthquake** as had not occurred since men were on the earth. (Rev 16:18)
